The Liturgy of Light

The Liturgy of Light is the same celebration that the Church begins with at the Easter Vigil. The church is dark and the Paschal (Easter) Candle is blessed and lit. Slowly the church begins to be filled with candlelight as each of the faithful receives their own lit candle from the Paschal Candle. It is so beautiful! We do this celebration when we return from Easter with all the children, not just Level One. But what is truly fascinating with Level One children is that this is how they come to know in a concrete way Jesus as Risen!

Seeing this light, they come to know the profound mystery of the resurrection. When children don't have a lived experience with this celebration, the empty tomb work which the Kindergarten children will do, is a difficult one. They will try to put a Jesus in the tomb. When they experience the Liturgy of Light, they are so matter-of-fact...of course the tomb is empty! Because Jesus' Light is stronger than any darkness or death. It truly is beautiful!
