



Dear St. Robert Families -

With gratitude to God, I am excited to announce that Bishop Boyea is transferring a parochial vicar to St. Robert and Good Shepherd effective Thursday, August 1st. Fr. Ginu Abraham will be joining us from Sacred Heart Parish in Hudson, where he has been serving with their pastor, Fr. Todd Koenigsknecht, for the past 3 years. Fr. Ginu is a religious order priest from the Missionaries of St. Francis de Sales, and has lived and served in the Diocese of Lansing since 2021. Prior to that, he served for 19 years in the Philippines.

This process has been unfolding quickly and discreetly under the diligent work of our Bishop, who has brought about this good news for us. Now that Sacred Heart Parish has publicized Fr. Ginu's departure from their community, I'm also able to publicize his arrival to our community. Naturally, several developments accompany this good news, and I'd like to address two of them here:
